This is a hands on workshop using tar paper to make slab built mugs, vases, bowls, and more. If you've made pots with slabs before learning to use tar paper makes it SOOO much easier! All skill levels welcome. Elaine will demonstrate basic pieces at the beginning of class so that you will be able to make a mug, a vase, and/or a bowl that day. Many students make several pots. The afternoon is for making your own with her help. Her glazing technique will also be demonstrated.

Things to bring:

1. A sack lunch.
2. Any tools you already have for clay work.
3. Texturing tools, such as a piece of driftwood, rocks, buttons, forks, screw drivers, etc. Start looking at everything in terms of what it would look like to push it into some clay. She has tools to share if you bring only your hands.
4. About a half bag of clay. Elaine uses two different colors of clay with similar shrinkage so contact Leslie Ceramics for recommendations.
