This is a hands on workshop using tar paper to make slab built mugs, vases, bowls, and more. I will also demonstrate how to glaze your textured pieces in the way I do for my product line. If you've made pots with slabs before learning to use tar paper makes it SOOO much easier! If you have no previous hand building experience don't worry! I will go over basic pieces at the beginning of class so that you will be able to make a mug, a vase, and/or a bowl that day. Many students made several pots in one day at the last workshop! This is easy and fun!

Things to bring:

1. A sack lunch or money for the Corralitos Market just down the block.
2. Any tools you already have for clay work.
3. Texturing tools, such as a piece of driftwood, rocks, buttons, forks, screw drivers, etc. Start looking at everything in terms of what it would look like to push it into some clay! I have tools to share if you bring nothing!
4. Your own clay if you plan on taking your pots away with you at the end of the workshop.
5. A materials fee of \$35 will be collected at the workshop if you choose to buy clay and glazes from me and have me fire your pots for you. This will also mean you must return to glaze your pieces on a second day TBD at the class.
